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Teaching Tips: Using a bright colored 8 ½" x 11" piece of paper, make a hamburger fold. On the top flap, cut out and glue the 3 titles (seceded, border, and free). Underneath the flap, glue the corresponding state names. Cut the paper apart between each section so that you have 3 flaps. On the inside bottom section, glue a copy of a US map dated 1864. Students color the states, with each group a different color (seceded, free, border) Maps can be obtained from Mapmaker toolkit or any other map source.
