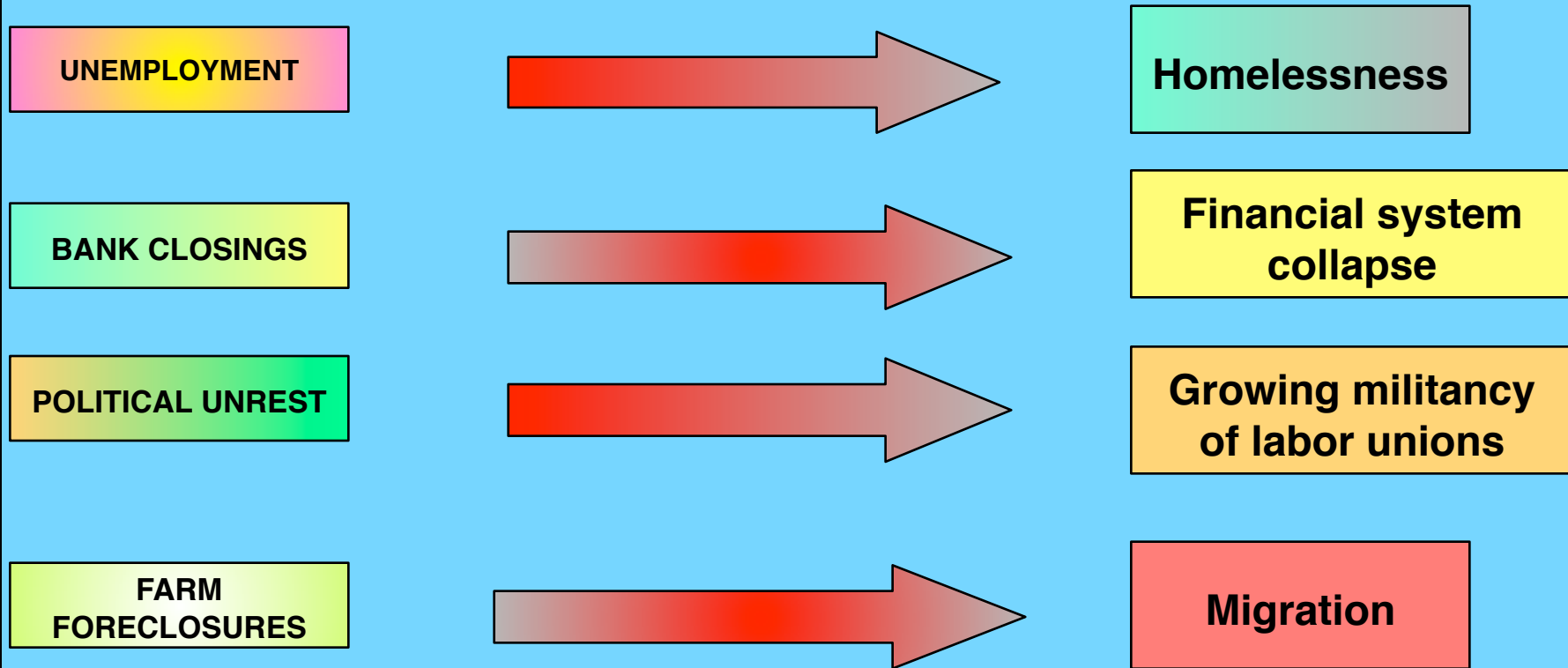

# IMPACT OF THE GREAT DEPRESSION
